

These attractive Haldane spinning wheels, are made from the finest kiln dried, European beech; a timber noted for its strength, fine grain and durability.

Suitable for both the beginner and the experienced spinner, they are stable and easy to treadle.

A lazy kate, with two bobbins, is supplied. The Orkney has an additional feature, which allows the bobbin holder part to locate on the wheel base

Different drive-pulleys are available, to alter the ratio between the wheel and flyer.

A large flyer with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " orifice, and three 250 gram bobbins for spinning bulky yarn, is available either as original equipment or as an extra, on the Lewis only.

Each wheel comes complete with clear instructions, and is easily assembled.

THE LEWIS

A precision made wheel with traditional appearance and charm, it has been designed to give long, trouble free service.

The wheel runs on concealed ball-bearings and the bobbins use special low-friction bushes. It has a double drive and can run equally well when fitted with the single band kit.

Made from the finest seasoned beech, this wheel is available polished or in a natural finish ready for waxing or staining.
